With the development of the Coronavirus worldwide, I would like to remind everyone of the vulnerability of our residents in care, and the responsibilities we all share in minimising risk of any illness to those in our care. Quite simply, if you are unwell at all, please do not visit the facility. Doing so places our residents at risk, many of whom have reduced immune systems and other underlying medical conditions making them more susceptible to illnesses.

We ask the same of our wonderful staff, whom are all very conscious of this requirement. Very simply, the wellbeing of our residents must come first. Please be mindful of this and respect this for the benefit of our Elders in care.

As advised in last months newsletter, we were working towards submitting our plans to council for Development Application approval in February. I am very pleased to advise this occurred on the 11th February. Plans are now with council to review, and available to the public. We will have the finalized plans on display here also for anyone interested in reviewing. The next steps for us is to wait until we receive some initial feedback from council. Once we are confident that the plans are likely to be approved, we will then move into Detailed Construction drawings development.

We are still looking for volunteers to assist with our bus outings. If you, or someone you know has an appropriate licence and experience driving a bus, and can spare some time, we would love to hear from you.

I would like to welcome Cathryn Rodgers to BlueWave, taking up the role of Clinical Manager overseeing our Nursing Home (High Care) area.
