Dear Resident, Family and Friends,

With the recent occurrence of community transmission from unknown sources in Sydney, some new rules have come into place effective immediately for all Aged Care Facilities in Sydney, Central Coast and Blue Mountains.

The following requirements are now in place;

- All visitors and staff are to wear surgical masks
- Residents may only receive a maximum of two visitors per day
- Visitors must only visit residents in their private rooms, or in an outdoor area. Visitors are not to interact with other resident, or spend time in communal areas.
- Visitors (and staff) who have been to any area of concern (as listed on the NSW Health website) are not to enter an Aged Care Facility.
- Also please note, from the 1st June, visitors must provide evidence of having the 2021 influenza vaccine, or will not be permitted to enter an Aged Care Facility.

We are hopeful that these restrictions may only be in place for a short time, subject to any further community cases occurring.
