Dear Residents, Family and Friends,

With the recent report of three community COVID cases in Sydney, new restrictions which are now a little closer have come into place effective immediately for Aged Care Facilities in NSW.

- Visitors must not enter an aged care facility at all if they have been to any close or casual contact locations in the last 14 days (as listed on the NSW Health website).
- We will update this list daily, and it is displayed on our windows prior to entering our facility. Please ensure you read and note updated list and do not enter if you have been to any listed location.
- If further community transmission occurs, there may be further changes/measures put in place, similar to what we have had in the past – please be aware this can change at short notice and may be in place upon arrival.

Another reminder from the 1st June, visitors must provide evidence of having the 2021 influenza vaccine, or will not be permitted to enter an Aged Care Facility. This is in line with NSW Health requirements. If you have not had the vaccination, entry will only be permitted under extraordinary circumstances and must be approved by a Clinical Manager.

The Flu vaccination is an annual requirement, and there is a new version of the vaccination each year. You must provide evidence of this year's influenza vaccination.
